		Capitalizations for beginning sentences & all names-proper nouns
		Punctuation for each sentence - end marks
		Did I write about the topic? Did you stick to your <b>topic</b> ? What is it asking me to do?
		Is my writing <b>organized</b> ?
		7-up sentence (7 or more words per sentence) NO BABY SENTENCES!
		Do you have at least <b>7</b> sentences per paragraph for your bing, bang, & bong.
		Rich vocabulary words – <b>synonyms</b> -make several changes
		<b>Introduction</b> : Is there a hook at the beginning? Ask a ?, use adjectives to describe/ make a quote or
		an outrageous statement. Use an effective introduction. Is it catchy? Need at least 4 sentences: a
		hook, a topic sentence, & combine 3 subtopics.
		Did I write in <b>complete sentences</b> & paragraphs? Check for <b>run-ons &amp; fragments</b> .
		Did I give 3 or more supporting details for each (subtopic) paragraph. Bing, Bang, Bong
		Neat or messy-is it handwritten or typed? Are they typos?
	1	Does it make <b>sense</b> ? Does it flow w/ beginning, middle, and an end?
		Uses <b>transitions</b> words at the beginning of each paragraph to link or join.
		Did I use proper spacing between words and sentences? 2 spaces after end mark.
		Did I use the wrong <b>homonyms</b> ? Check they're/there/their,
		Are there 5 paragraphs? Introduction, bing, bang, bong, & conclusion
		Did you use a thesaurus? Replace words for clearer expressions or details.
		Is the proper format followed? 14 Font- double spaced New Times Roman/Calibri/Ariel
		Check your 5 senses and add details: touch, see, hear, taste, & smell.
		Check you <b>Subject &amp; Verbs</b> to see if they agree with tense & singular/plural
		Did you add any <b>prepositional</b> phrases, appositives, literary techniques like: metaphor, similies,
		hyperboles, & personification?
		Check your verbs? Are they powerful?
		Check your <b>dead words</b> , did you use said/got/went/ etc. a lot?
		Add details with <b>adjectives</b> & adverbs
		Check the 1 <sup>st</sup> four words of each paragraph, do they all start the same?
		Look at your sentence structure: do you have S, CD, CX1, CX2, CD-CX types of sentences?
		Did you use conjunctions correctly? Put your finger on the conjunction & check each. side.
		Commas for dates, series of items, appositives, before conjunctions w/ 2 complete sentences. Check
		for comma splices.
		Did you use too many <b>pronouns</b> ? Try not to use I.
		<b>Tense</b> : don't just write in past tense, change it to present tense and put the reader there in the story.
		Did you <b>zoom</b> in with your camera and give more details? Use binoculars too.
		did you spell out number words 0-20?
		Did you use any contractions? If so change them.
		Did you use slang? Did you use dialogue and use "quotes" properly?
		Did you start w/ "My name is" or "I am going to tell you about"? If so get rid of it!
		If this is <b>persuasive</b> , did I try to convince my reader and state what I what them to do?
	+	Is this paper on target for my audience that I am writing to? Who? Kids vs. adults
	+	Ask? Why? When? How? Where? What kind? If it is not clear in the story.
		Did you read it <b>out loud to</b> yourself? No one is going to think you are crazy!!!
		Did I write a <b>conclusion</b> ? Thesis statement! Restate your topic sentence
		Did you save your work to the <b>H drive</b> and name it?
